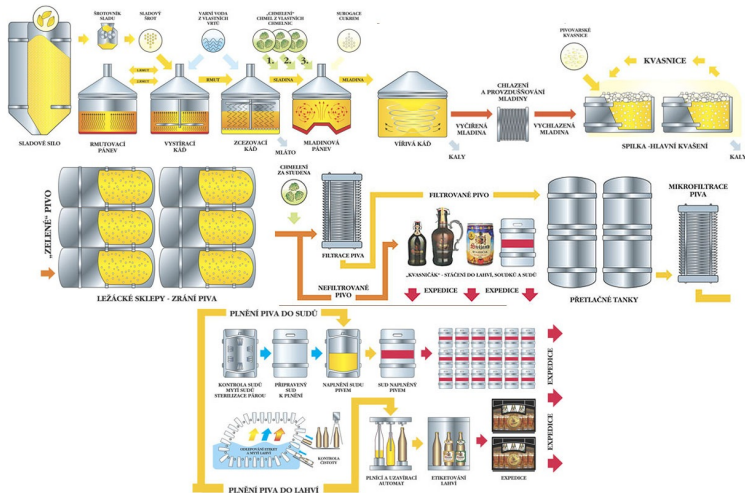


Figure 1: Diagram of brewing. Source: Brewery Svijany.

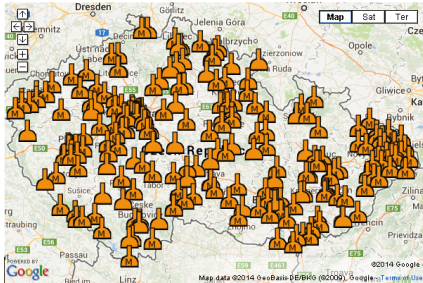


Figure 3: Czech breweries.

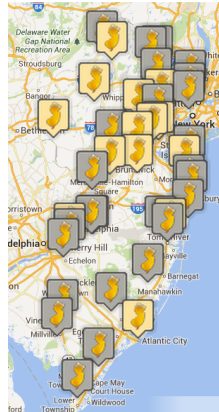


Figure 4: New Jersey breweries.
